

Hello all---

Attached is the "Current Working DRAFT of the Plan Update", dated 30 May 06.

We have recently been in a cycle of making a few comments, making a couple changes, and issuing a new draft every week or two. That period has come to an end.

At this point we plan to have this draft, and one more draft, and then the final product to submit to the city -- so if you have final comments, the time is NOW!

Here's the schedule of the process of amending the plan update from here to the final document:

Today, June 2nd:

Current Working Draft sent out to N-PUT members and posted on website for the public.

[**Comment period:** public and team encouraged to review draft and make comments. Community Forum Tues June 6th and postering to encourage people to read and review plan]

June 16th:

Deadline for comments on "current working draft" .

[**Revise Plan Update:** Greg will review all comments submitted and take first crack at revising plan update. N-PUT working session on Thursday June 22nd to review changes and discuss and complex issues. Create "FINAL Working Draft".]

June 27th:

Present "FINAL Working Draft" of Plan Update to the community at RNA general meeting. Copy posted on Website and available for distribution.

[**Comment period:** public reviews "FINAL working draft" and makes any final comments.]

July 11th:

Deadline for comments on "FINAL working draft" .

[**Revise Plan Update:** Greg will review all comments submitted and take first crack at revising plan update. LAST (!) N-PUT meeting on Thursday July 13th to review changes and discuss and complex issues. Create "FINAL Draft".]

July 14th:

Submit FINAL Draft of Plan Update to City for DPD's review of items relating to update of Seattle's comprehensive plan.

And that's it. A bit more than a month and only two comment periods remaining. If you've got anything to suggest or comment on **NOW IS THE TIME!**
